Rules of the Road and Safety

BIKES HAVE EQUAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE USE OF PUBLIC ROADS.

Because cyclist share the road with motor vehicles and pedestrians, it is essential to use common sense, ride cautiously, and obey all traffic laws. Cyclist must do this (and encourage others to do the same) to earn the respect of drivers for the benefit of everyone.

- * Always ride with the flow of traffic.
- * Ride defensively, be alert!
- * Stop at red lights and stop signs.
- * Ride predictably.
- * Use hand signals when making a turn.
- * Ride single-file when riding with friends.
- * Yield to pedestrians.
- * Walk you bike on sidewalks.
- * Night riding requires a light and reflectors.
- * Use extra caution when riding at night.
- * Longer rides require provisions (food, water, etc.).
